The ASHRAE Standard titled Legionellosis: Risk Management for Building Water Systems can be obtained at <http://spc188.ashraepcs.org/>. This standard provides minimum Legionellosis risk management requirements for the design, construction, commissioning, operation, maintenance, repair, replacement and expansion of new and existing buildings and their associated (potable and non-potable) water systems and components. Our program in Orlando next month will include a presentation on this subject—please see this offering and the complete program inside on page 2.

Thanks to everyone for the hard work at all levels to assure the continued success of our organization. The board is very humbled to serve you. I look forward to seeing as many of you as possible at the Annual Meeting.

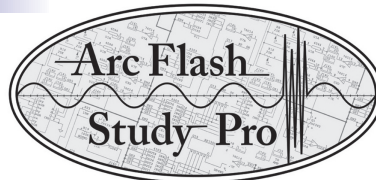

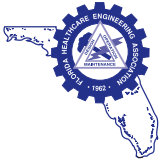
